

Lab 6: ReactJS and routes. (5 points). Due March 23f, by 5pm.

1. Use this link to get the github repo: <https://classroom.github.com/a/4ZhnD2ll>
2. Create/update the .gitignore file.
3. Create a ReactJS app using vite with the template, using the npm command found on slide 5 of react 1 lecture.
4. Install the React-router-dom using npm install react-router-dom
5. Choose BrowserRouter or CreateBrowserRouter method
 - a. Create at least 3 routes, one must be / and the other 2 are up to you.
6. Create 3 different components to display, one for each route.
7. The / route needs links to the other 2 routes, using either NavLink to OR Link to OR something like a button and the useNavigate() method.
 - a. You should include a "back" button on the 2 routes, but it's optional
 - b. You can add routes with parameter or state, but that is optional.

Turn in:

1. Make sure the readme has been updated, name, lab6.
2. Update the AI use section
3. Add a description of website, how it works, and screen shots showing it works.
 - a. At least 3 screen shots, one for each route.
4. Finally make sure you push everything to get github.
